Correspondences

Colors: black, orange, red, brown, yellow

stones: obsidian, bloodstone, onyx, jet

Herbs, Plants & Spices: bay, cinnamon, cloves, ginger, pumpkin,
sunflowers, rosemary, mugwort, myrrh, sage

Ritual

sit skyclad or loosely clothed.

Light a white, black, orange or red candle and place so the reflection appears in a mirror or bowl of water. Meditate on the image, reflecting on and connecting with those who have passed on.

Take a bite of bread and a sip of wine or cider, alternating until gone. Blow out the candle.

TO REMEMBER A PAST LIFE

Set a white candle next to a mirror so the light from it can hit your face but you will not see the candle in the mirror. Turn off the lights and sit in front of the mirror.

Look into your eyes and say the words:

"Oracle of lunar light, send me the second sight"

Repeat and concentrate until your reflection becomes that of someone else. Try to look at the face, body, clothing and surroundings to understand more about your past life.

TO BANISH NEGATIVITY

Compile a list of bad habits and negative situations in your life and write them all down on a sheet of paper. Stir a teaspoon each of cayenne, coffee and cloves into a cup and a half of water and heat.

Wad up a paper towel, dip it into the hot water and drag over the paper to dye it brown. Hang the sheet up to dry (or use a blow dryer.)

Once the paper has dried, burn it in the fireplace or Samhain bonfire to banish the negativity and bad habits.

Ways to Celebrate

Carve gungkins to protect your home and family.

Make a besom.

Make door wreaths and other decorations.

Toast gungkin seeds.

Hold a bonfire.

Set up an ancestor altar.

Visit a cemetery and leave flowers for passed loved ones or even strangers.

Play Samhain divination games like discovering the first letter of your true love's name with an apple peel.

Yule

Winter Solstice ~ Late December

"Midwinter"

Correspondences

Colors: Red, Green, White, Gold

Stones: Quartz, Ruby, Diamond, Pearl, Garnet

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Mistletoe, Balsam, fir, Holly, Pine, Ivy,
Cinnamon, Cloves

Ritual

Sit skyclad or loosely clothed.

Light several red, green, white or gold candles. focus on the flame of a central candle, contemplating death, rebirth and adding your personal light and that of the ritual to the world on the longest night of the year.

Take a bite of gingerbread and a sip of tea or cider, alternating

until gone. Blow out the candle.

BLESSED BE.

Spells

TO SPREAD PEACE

Follow the recipe for sugarglums, imbuing the sweets with peaceful energy as you work. When they are finished, place a white candle in a large bowl or tray and surround with the sugarglums.

Light the candle and sprinkle moonwater around the outside of the dish, saying the words:

"Bless these treats with peace and love and intentions sweet"

Serve the sugarglums at a holiday gathering.

Ways to Celebrate

Burn a traditional Yule log.

Donate food and clothing.

Decorate an evergreen tree, inside, outside or both.

Keep lots of candles burning as much as possible.

Bake gingerbread and gingerbread cookies in Yuletide shapes, imbuing the dough with intention and blessings.

Mix your own mulling spices.

Take a leisurely bath surrounded by candles, using ritual soap or sea salt to cleanse yourself of any physical and emotional toxins.

Enchant the gifts you give with good luck and prosperity.

Leave blessed treats outside for winter animals.

Make Witches' Balls and other crafts to hang on the tree.

Imbolc

February 2nd
"Festival of Light"

Correspondences

Colors: White, Red, Yellow, Silver, Pink

Stones: Amethyst, Garnet, Onyx

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Basil, Clover, Leather, Willow, All yellow flowers

Ritual

Sit skyclad or loosely clothed.

Light one or more white, red or yellow candles, focusing on cleansing your life of negativity. Stand to glass and light a small votive candle (contained in a votive holder) in each window of the house, anointing the glass with salted water or moonwater to purify.

Take a bite of buttered bread and a sip of tea, alternating until gone. Blow out the altar candles, leave the window candles until they burn themselves out.

TO PURIFY THE HOME

Drizzle local honey over the cut side of half a grapefruit and consume for breakfast or as a snack. As you eat, set aside the grapefruit seeds.

Wash the seeds, rinsing with salted water to cleanse them. Place the seeds in a sachet with sage leaves and eucalyptus. Tuck the sachet someplace centrally located in the home such as a couch cushion.

Ways to Celebrate

Hold a bonfire.

Ritual cleansing especially long baths imbued with herbs or flowers.

Make and anoint candles.

Make homemade butter.

Leave buttered bread out for the faeries.

Clean your house top to bottom and perform a blessing.

Knit or crochet a wool scarf or other garment.

Vernal Equinox ~ Late March

"first Day of Spring"

Correspondences

Colors: Pink, Green, Yellow, Pale Blue, Lavender

Stones: Amethyst, Aquamarine, Rose Quartz, Moonstone

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Crocus, Daffodil, Honesty, Iris, Jasmine, Rose, Peony, Violets, Tulips

Ritual

Sit skyelad or loosely clothed.

Light a white or pastel candle, in view of the rising sun, if possible.

Handwrite a blessing for growth and beginnings, placing it in the bottom of a small pot. Gently scoop soil over the blessing. Press three seeds into the soil and sprinkle with moonwater.

Take a bite of a dot cross bun and a sig of tea, alternating until gone. Blow out the candle.

Spells

TO BLESS A SPRING GARDEN

Tie a knot at one end of green, white and brown ribbons and braid them together tightly, tying a second knot at the other end. Tie a third knot in the center, fourth and fifth knots on one side and sixth and seventh knots on the other. Tie the cord onto a 2x4 wooden stake with a blessing written on it and place at the entrance to the garden.

TO BLESS NEW SEEDS

Anoint a white or green candle with olive oil infused with cilantro. Place a packet of seeds in front of you and sprinkle sea salt over it to cleanse the seeds. Carefully open the packet and pour the seeds into a marked plastic bag.

Slice open the packet on the sides and bottom. Write a blessing for health, prosperity and abundance on the blank side of the front cover and place inside the bag with the seeds. After the seeds have been planted, use the blessed packet as a marker in the garden.

Ways to Celebrate

Color fresh eggs with homemade dyes.

Host an egg hunt.

Practice balance with yoga.

Beltane

May 1st

"The Beginning of Summer"

Correspondences

Colors: Green, Pink, Yellow, Blue, Brown

Stones: Emerald, Amber, Sapphires, Rose Quartz

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Almond, Ash, Clover, Mint, Thyme, Ivy, All
Spring flowers

Ritual

Sit skyclad or loosely clothed.

Place one or more white pillar or floating candles in a glass bowl and fill it with a few inches of moonwater. Light the candles. Decorate the "well" with ribbons, flowers and greenery. Meditate on the well, contemplating the Goddess and wishes for the coming months. Eat fresh fruit with local wine or iced tea. Blow out the candles.

Blessed Be.

Spells

TO OPEN YOUR HEART TO LOVE

Bake a batch of chocolate cookies, stirring in organic dried rose petals and freeze-dried raspberries.

Light a white candle and meditate, focusing on opening your heart to love and attracting a healthy, fulfilling relationship into your life.

Drink a glass of red wine with at least one of the cookies.

Ways to Celebrate

Make flower wreaths for your hair.

Hold a bonfire.

Plant a faerie garden and leave gifts for the faeries.

Construct and dance around the Maypole.

Take a picnic into nature and gather herbs and flowers.

Use the water from your Beltane well to nourish and bless the garden.

Midsummer

Summer Solstice ~ Late June

"A Midsummer Night's Dream"

Correspondences

Colors: Blue, Green, Gold, Yellow

Stones: Lapis lazuli, Diamond, Emerald, Jade

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Chamomile, Wild rose, Lilies, Lavender, fennel,
Thyme, Wisteria, Verbena, St. John's Wort, Oak

Ritual

Sit skyelad or loosely clothed.

Light a white, green, yellow or gold candle.

Bless an offering of flowers and cake for the faeries. Meditate
on the flame, opening yourself to friendly brownies and pixies and
inviting them in.

Take a bite of cake and a sig of local wine or iced tea, alternating
until gone. Blow out the candle, leaving the offering

TO WELCOME THE FAERIES

Mix 8-10 drops ylang ylang or rosemary essential oil with 1 cup of distilled water and pour into a small spray bottle, labeling with the scent. Spray the mist in areas such as a patio or even around house plants to welcome friendly faeries.

Ways to Celebrate

Make a faerie door somewhere inside your home or garden.

Go on a picnic.

Pick fresh fruit and vegetables for a feast.

Hold a Midsummer night's party in the woods or a field.

Lammas

August 1st

"The first harvest festival"

Correspondences

Colors: Brown, Yellow, Gold, Orange

Stones: Aventurine, Peridot, Citrine

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Ash, Caraway, Wheat, Sunflowers, Marjoram

Ritual

Sit sky-clad indoors or loosely clothed in the garden.

Light a white, yellow or gold candle. Meditate on the flame, focusing on both the blessings in your life and the sacrifices you need to make.

Take a bite of cornbread and a sip of wine, alternating until gone. Blow out the candle.

Blessed be.

Spells

FOR AN ABUNDANT GARDEN

Handwrite a blessing for continued prosperity and positive abundance. Lay a snipped leaf from the garden and a few heads of wheat on the blessing and tie the bundle with a piece of twine. Burn the bundle or bury it in the garden.

TO PROTECT THE HOME

Bake a small loaf of bread, mixing in about a tablespoon of caraway seeds. Once the loaf has cooled, break it into four pieces with your hands. Walk to each corner of the house and bury one piece of bread, saying "Protection in the East," "Protection in the South" and so on.

Ways to Celebrate

Bake bread of all kinds.

Make preserves, jellies or jams, especially from fruits you grew.

Share your harvest with friends and family.

Donate canned food.

Infuse oils and vinegars.

Make a corn dolly.

Save stale bread to feed the birds.

Autumnal Equinox ~ Late September
"The Witches' Thanksgiving"

Correspondences

Colors: Brown, Violet, Red, Orange, Gold

Stones: Carnelian, Smoky Quartz, Yellowagate

Herbs, Plants & Spices: Apple, Cinnamon, Nutmeg, Vines, Sage, Oak

Ritual

Sit skyclad or loosely clothed.

Light a white, brown, purple or gold candle, reflecting
on what you have to be thankful for.

Cut an apple in half to show the five-pointed star in the center and
eat in quiet reflection with a glass of cider. Blow out the candle.

Spells

TO KEEP BLESSINGS IN ONE'S LIFE

As they come to you, write down at least five blessings in your life.

Tear the paper into small pieces and either:

- Mix in a sachet with appropriate herbs and spices such as cinnamon, nutmeg, sage, oak leaves or dried apple peel. Tuck the sachet somewhere it will always be near to you to always keep the blessings close.
- Mix in a small jar, vial or muslin bag with appropriate herbs and spices such as cinnamon, nutmeg, sage, oak leaves or dried apple peel. Bury the container near your home to always keep the blessings close.

TO PROTECT THE HOME

Gather a piece of eucalyptus, sage leaves and an oak twig (preferably with leaves still attached.)

Cut a piece of twine at about 18 inches and center a cedar "hang-up" on the string. Lay the oak, eucalyptus and sage on top of the piece of cedar.

Wrap the twine around the cedar and other ingredients several times.

Tie a knot at the back of the piece of cedar so it is tight enough to hold all the pieces together. Hang up in a closet or other location to purify and protect the home.

Ways to Celebrate

Volunteer at a soup kitchen.

Donate canned food.

Make stamping projects such as tote bags using an apple cut in half from top to bottom to show the five-pointed star in the center.

Hold a family feast.

Create gift baskets of baked goods, seasonal crows and wine or ale for friends and family.

Fill a cornucopia with seasonal fruits and vegetables and place in the center of the family table.

Visit a pick-your-own farm and gather apples and pumpkins.

Make a centerpiece by filling a vase with wheat stalks, colored leaves and dry branches.

Hang apples on a tree as natural birdfeeders.
